SourceDK Viewing SourceDK Help File in the Excel 2007/2010 Update

To access the interactive Help file, you will need to download an extension from Microsoft.com.

You only need to do this once. To get the extension do this:

- a. Click on any “Help” button in the Toolkit.
- b. In the “Why can’t I get Help from this program?” window that pops up, click on “Microsoft Help and Support” (last line of the message).
- c. On the page that pops up, scroll down to the “Resolution” tab to get to:

Download the appropriate version of Windows Help program (WinHlp32.exe) , depending on the operating system that you are using:

- d. Click to download the appropriate file for your computer.
 - e. Click “continue” to download the .exe file (this file makes sure your operating system is genuine). This file will give you a code at the end.
 - f. Copy and paste the code in the space for the code in Step d.
 - g. Download the file.
 - h. Once the file has been downloaded you can either
 - i. close and restart the Toolkit (and the software will automatically find the Help file), or
 - ii. you can click on the Help button and manually navigate to the SourceDK folder and select the “**SourceDK.HLP**” file.
 - i. You only need to do this once. The next time you run the Toolkit, it will automatically find the Help file.
